

TALKING POINTS on The Affordable Health Plan – House Bill 4452

- When you reach the office of your State Senator and State Representative let them know that you are a registered voter in the district and give your address.
- You will likely be speaking with a staff member and not the member. Ask them to make sure that they pass along your message.
- “I’m calling in support of House Bill 4452 --the Affordable Health Plan.”
- “This plan could reduce premiums for many small businesses by as much as 22%.”
- “This bill would create a much-needed new insurance product with benefits equivalent to the Connector’s Commonwealth Choice Bronze Level coverage. It would be available to all small employers (50 or fewer employees) and individuals, and could be purchased through or outside the Connector.”
- “It limits the rates doctors and hospitals charge for this one product to no more than 10% above what the federal Medicare program pays and would limit insurer profits on all products sold to small employers to no more than 2%.”
- “I’m calling today to ask that State Senator/State Representative _____ support this bill.”
- Ask the office to get back to you if they don’t yet have a position on the bill.
